

# FAQ'S

## **What should dancer's wear?**

Girls: Black leotards, pink tights, pink ballet slippers

Boys: Black shorts, white t-shirt, black shoes

## **How many classes per week should students attend?**

Recommended: Preballet & Ballet I-4 to 6 times per month

Ballet II 2 times per week

Ballet II 3 times per week

## **How is hair to be worn?**

Hair must be up in a bun. No pony tails. If hair is too short to put in a bun, it must be pinned back, completely out of child's face.

## **Where do I buy dancer's attire?**

We recommend Dance Haven, 1310 North Green River Rd, in Woodland Center, Phone # 962-0024 for 1 stop shopping.

Target and Walmart also carry some less expensive dance attire.

## **Can I film my child during class?**

No. However, you are welcome to video tape your child dancing on the dance floor immediately after class.

## **Can I film my child during a performance?**

No pictures or video tape are allowed during a performance. However, you are welcome to video tape or take pictures before or after the performance as well as during dress rehearsal.

## **What should I do if I am late for class?**

The student should wait by the door until instructor welcomes child into class.

## **How many classes can I attend?**

Your monthly tuition covers as many or as few classes as you wish to attend.

## **When is tuition due?**

Tuition is due on the first of the month.

**What is the late fee?**

The tuition late fee is \$5.00.

**How do the tuition scholarships work?**

Scholarships are based only on financial resources. \$5.00 is the minimum monthly tuition. All dancers, including those receiving scholarships must pay the annual registration fee.
